How can I get a REAL ID?

Beginning in September 2018, you may bring your REAL ID documentation to any PennDOT Driver License Center for verification. Once REAL IDs are available in spring 2019, you will be able to order your REAL ID online—no need to go back to the driver license center!

Once you order your REAL ID online, PennDOT will use your most recent photo on file and your new REAL ID will arrive in the mail within 7-10 business days.

After REAL IDs are available, you will have three options for obtaining a REAL ID:

- Apply online (pre-verified customers only)
- Visit any PennDOT Driver License Center to have your documents verified and imaged, receive your REAL ID in the mail within 7-10 business days
- Visit one of up to 13 REAL ID Centers statewide to have your documents verified and imaged, receive your REAL ID at the time of service



Pre-Verify Online!

If you received your **FIRST** Pennsylvania driver's license, learner's permit or photo ID card AFTER September 1, 2003, PennDOT may already have your REAL ID documentation on file.

To find out if your required REAL ID documents are on file with PennDOT, visit www.PennDOT.gov/REALID.

If PennDOT confirms that your documents are on file, you can order your REAL ID online when they are available in spring 2019—no need to visit a driver's license center!

Things to Remember:



Individual federal facilities—including military installations—may have different security measures and accepted forms of identification may vary. Contact the facility in advance of your visit to learn what forms of ID will be accepted.



After October 1, 2020, you will need a REAL ID (or another TSA-approved form of ID) to board a commercial flight, even within the U.S.



You will still need a valid passport to travel internationally

What is REALID?

The REALID Act is a federal law that a ects how states issue driver splicenses and ID cards if they are going to be acceptable for federal purposes, such as boarding a domes- c commercial ' ight, or entering a military installa- on or federal facility that requires ID.

Beginning October 1, 2020, Pennsylvanians will need a REAL ID 60 mpliant license, iden-, ca- on card or another form of federally 20 ceptable iden-, ca- on (such as a valid passport or military ID) to:

- " Board domes- c commercial ' ights
- Enter a military base
- " Enter a federal facility that requires ID at the door


Do I have to get a REALID?

No. REAL ID is op* onal for Pennsylvania residents. You will be able to get either a REAL ID driver's license or iden-, ca- on card, or a standard driver's license or iden-, ca- on card.

If you do not get a REAL ID, you must have an alternate form of federally acceptable iden-, ca- on (valid passport, military ID, etc.) to board domes- c commercial ' ights and enter certain federal facili- es a lar October 1, 2020.

When can I get a REALID?

REAL IDs will be available to customers who want them in spring 2019.

How much will a REALID cost, and when will it expire?

You will pay a one in fee of \$30, plus a renewal fee (current renewal fee is \$30.50 for a four year non mmercial driver icense or a photo ID).

The expira- on date of your , rst REAL ID license or ID card will include any - me remaining on your current license or ID card, plus an addi* onal four years.

For example, if your license is set to expire in October 2020, but you upgrade to a REALID in October 2019, your new REALID compliant license or ID card won't expire un-I October 2024

This means that you wond <code>%ose+-</code> me that you gre already paid for. Aller your, rst REALID license or photo ID expires, there are no addi- onal fees to renew a REALID vs. a standard lissue ID.

If you are receiving your, rst Pennsylvania driver's license or photo ID and you'd like to get a REAL ID, you'll pay the one the REAL ID fee, plus the regular initial issuance fee (current initial issuance fee for a nonth mercial learner's permit and driver's license is \$35.50, \$30.50 for a photo ID).



How do I prepare to get a REALID?

The best thing you can do to prepare for REAL ID is to get your documents together.

Federal regula- ons require that PennDOT must verify the following documents for a customer before issuing a REAL ID:

" Proof of iden* ty

Original or cer-, ed copy of a birth cer-, cate with a raised seal, issued by an authorized government agency, or valid U.S. Passport.

- " Proof of Social Security number Social Security card.
- " Proof of all legal name changes

Marriage cer-, cate, court order or divorce decree issued by your county's family court.

Two proofs of current, physical PA address

Examples: Ourrent, unexpired PA license or ID and a no more than 90 day old bank statement or u-lity bill with the same name and address.

If you are a lawfully present non LLS ci-zen, acceptable documents include:

- " I 551 Permanent Resident Card (Green Card)
- " Passport with I 551 stamp
- " Machine Leadable Immigrant Visa
- " Relentry Permit I 327
